Encounters is published bi-annually (March and September) by the Islamic Foundation, UK. It will include articles, relevant documents and statements as well as book briefs of works in English, French, German, Arabic and Urdu. The Editors welcome contributions which stimulate understanding and critical evaluation of the areas mentioned above. Materials submitted should be original, previously unpublished, double-spaced with pages numbered consecutively and references at the end of the article. Articles should not exceed 10,000 words, and should include the contributor's name, address and a short *viae* indicating training, position and any publications. Each article should be accompanied by an abstract of 150-200 words.
